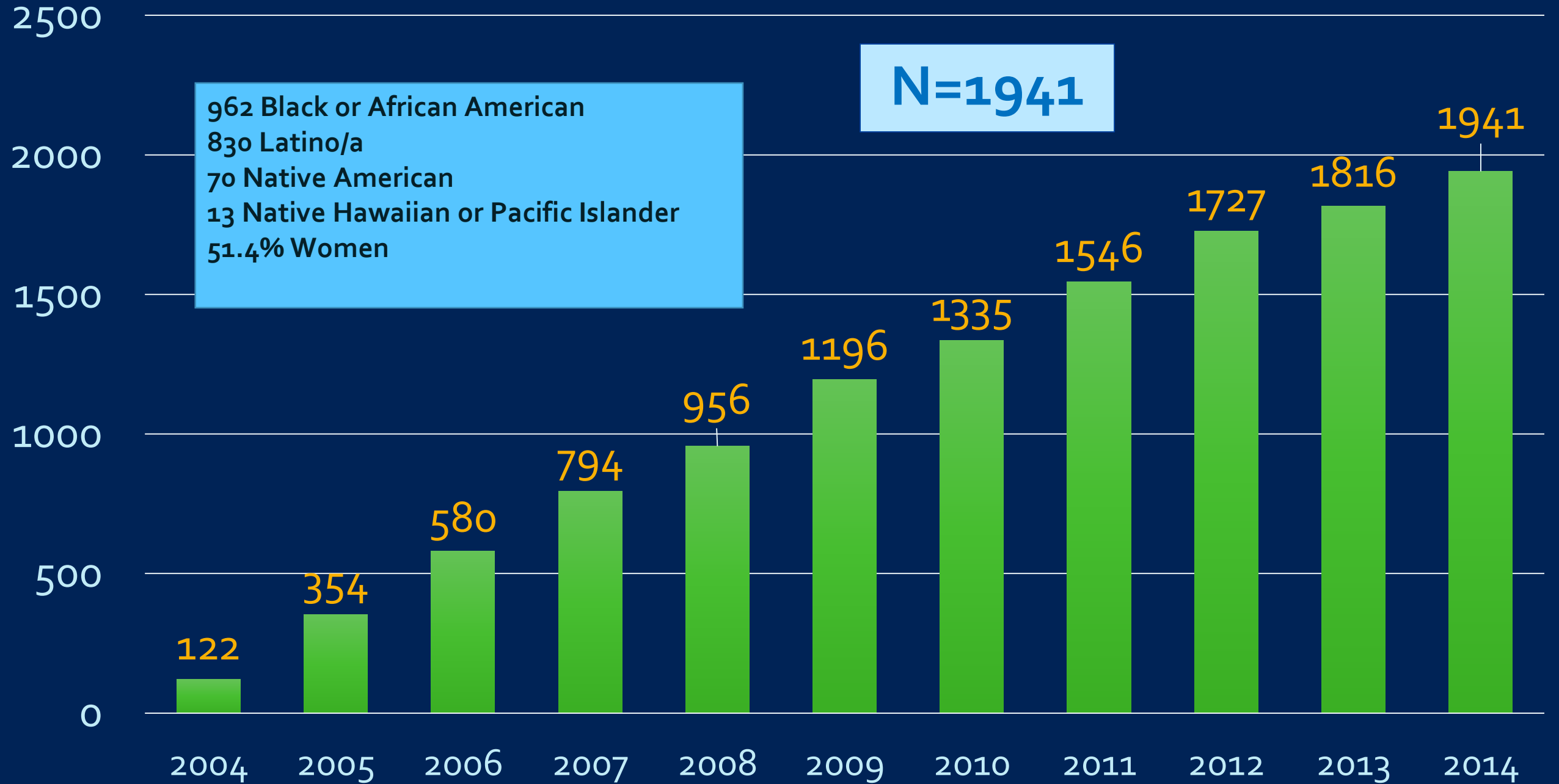

4. Recognize their efforts

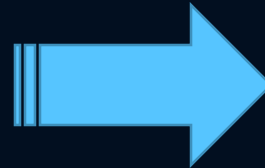
